

PDF Export Presets are a very practical way of getting all settings right every time. Once imported, the settings will remain permanently accessible on your computer.

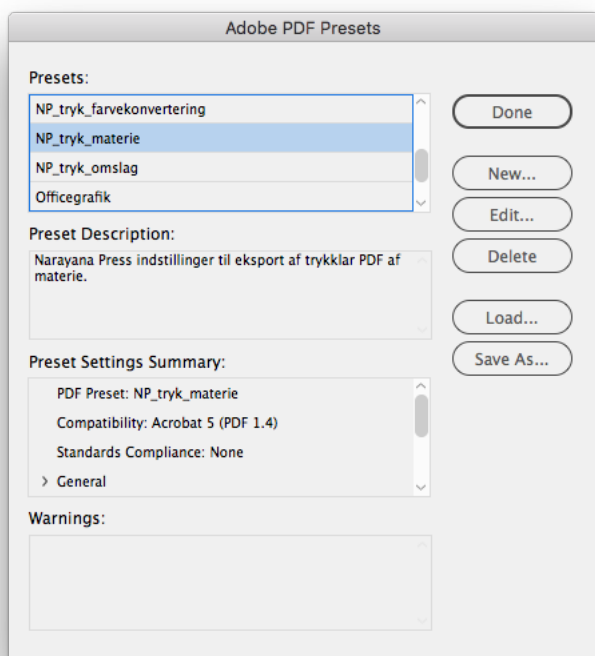
In the package you will find two files with settings for different purposes.

The basic settings for matter and cover are the same, the only difference being that covers need some extra space for cut marks and measures.

- **NP\_tryk\_materie** is for exporting the contents, including endpapers
- **NP\_tryk omslag** is for exporting cover files

### How to import PDF Export Presets

1. Select File > Adobe PDF Presets > Define...
2. Click Load..., select the .joboptions file you need, click Open, and then OK.  
You can only import one setting at a time.



#### About Preflight

Narayana Press checks all PDF's prior to printing, and will report back if there are any problems.

However, it is always a good idea to check the document yourself using InDesign's built-in Preflight before exporting a printable PDF.

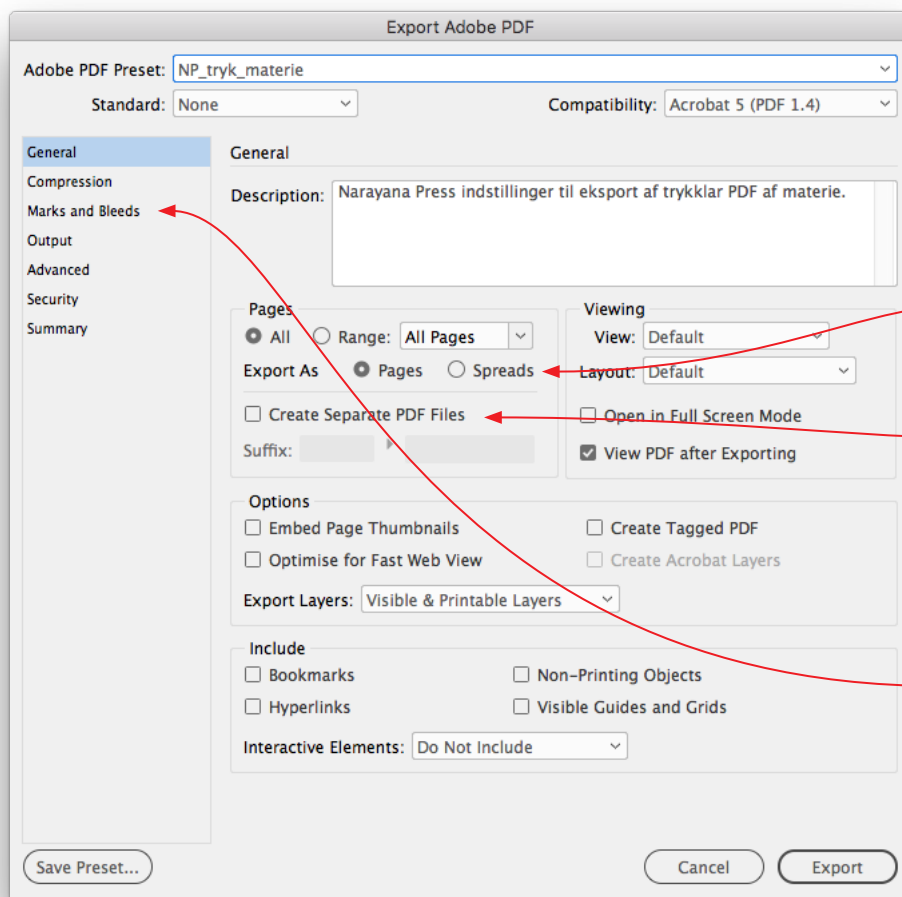
#### Color settings and color conversion

Narayana Press standard PDF Export Presets will not change the colors of neither document nor images, regardless of InDesign's Color Settings.

If you want to convert colors during PDF Export, you are always welcome to contact us and request Color Settings and Export Presets to match the images and the selected paper type exactly.

### How to export a printable PDF

3. Select File > Export ...
4. Select the name of the PDF and where it should be saved, select Format: Adobe PDF (Print), and click Save.
5. Select the desired Adobe PDF Preset, and click Export.

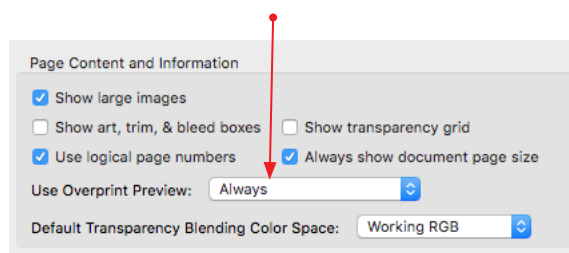


If your cover consists of more than one page, select Export As Spreads.

The size of the final PDF should not exceed 2 GB. If the images by themselves take up several gigabytes of space, the best solution is to export as single pages, by selecting Create Separate PDF Files.

If your hardcover document size does not include the 15-20 mm needed to fold over the edge of the cover, cropmarks should be placed with an offset of eg. 15 mm, og bleed should be 5 mm more, eg. 20 mm.

6. Check the final PDF carefully.  
To see how transparency, overprint and similar effects will look when printed, Overprint Preview must be turned on. In Adobe Acrobat Reader, this can be done by selecting *Preferences > Page Display > Use Overprint Preview: Always*.



#### A quick check of the settings in your PDF viewer:

### OVERPRINT FILL

If you see a green text on a blue background here, everything is fine. The text is yellow and has been set to Overprint Fill, causing it to mix with the blue background.

If you see a yellow text on a blue background, the settings are wrong.
